



Memorandum of Understanding between the Australian Institute of Building and the Hong Kong Institute of Clerks of Works

Preamble

This agreement between the Australian Institute of Building (AIB) and the Hong Kong Institute of Clerks of Works (HKICW) seeks to enhance cooperation between the two organisations and their memberships.

1. Professional Status

- 1.1. AIB and HKICW have a shared commitment to strong professional institutes within the building and construction industry.
- 1.2. AIB and HKICW recognise each other as the preeminent professional institute in their respective countries.
- 1.3. AIB and HKICW will work together to raise the level of professionalism in the building and construction industry.

2. Information Exchange

- 2.1. AIB and HKICW agree to exchange information in order to facilitate an understanding of each other's work.
- 2.2. AIB and HKICW will forward information distributed to their respective memberships such as magazines and newsletters to an individual nominated by each organisation.

3. Continuing Professional Development

- 3.1. AIB and HKICW will offer, where possible, each other's members the applicable member rate to continuing professional development events (such as seminars and training courses) run by their Institute.
- 3.2. AIB and HKICW agree to promote each other's continuing professional development events on their respective websites.

4. Promotion and Development of Agreement

- 4.1. AIB and HKICW agree to promote this Memorandum of Understanding on their websites.
- 4.2. The President and senior staff from each organisation will maintain dialogue on a regular basis to identify opportunities to strengthen the relationship.

5. Collaborative Activities

- 5.1. AIB and HKICW may enter into additional agreements to support collaborative activities to support their membership. Such agreements will be annexed to this Memorandum of Understanding.

6. Term of Agreement

- 6.1. AIB and HKICW agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall be for a fixed period of three years, after which there will be a formal review. Progress reviews will take place as and when appropriate.
